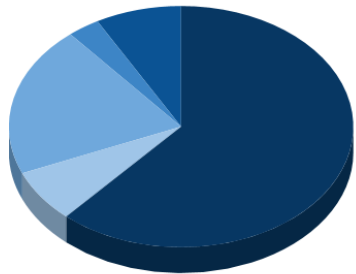

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

2022-2023 Revenues

We rely on local property tax as our main source of funding. We are able to tax through the levy - \$4.1M. As a result of the equalization formula through the State of Wisconsin, we receive various state aids. We also receive a small amount from the Federal Government. Open enrollment recruitment is the final form of revenue. Open enrollment revenue supports the maintenance of current programming.

2022-2023 Expenditures

We are very pleased to announce that 78% of our expenditures go towards the instruction of our students.

- Direct instructional costs (69%) include teaching salaries, professional development, and instructional materials (~ \$4.0M).
- Indirect instructional costs (13%) include guidance, educational assistants, library, administration and business services (~\$1.1M).
- Non-instructional costs (18%) include busing, operation of the building, maintenance, etc (~\$1.0M).

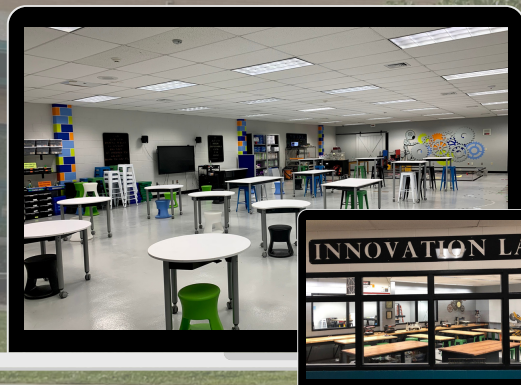
