Education is primarily a state function. Wisconsin Statutes provide for executing this function through delegation of power to the school districts of the state. The state, however, retains general control of the entire public school system.

The Lake Country School District is classified as a common school district. The official name of the District is:

The Joint School District Number One of the City of Delafield, Villages of Chenequa, Hartland and Nashotah, and Townships of Delafield and Merton.

The educational services of Lake Country School District shall consist of divisions as follows:

Primary School Grades: K-3
Intermediate School Grades: 4-5
Middle School Grades 6-8

and such other special classroom or programs as the Board may authorize the Superintendent to establish.
