DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR'S ROLE IN NEGOTIATIONS 1000.5

The Lake Country Board of Education designates the district administrator of schools as the official representative of the School Board on matters of common concern, as determined by the Board as being negotiable, in the preliminary stages of negotiations. However, the final decision on any matter and/or problem of common concern, considered by the Board as negotiable, shall be made by the Board.
