If a vacancy on the board occurs from death, resignation, removal, or other causes, the vacancy will be filled by a vote of the total Board of the Lake Country School District. When a vacancy occurs in the office of a board member who is in the last year of his or her term, or when a vacancy occurs after the spring election but on or before the last Tuesday in November in the office of a board member who is not in the last year of his or her term, the successor shall be elected at the next spring election. When a vacancy occurs after the last Tuesday in November and on or before the date of the next spring election in the office of a board member who is not in the last year of his or her term, the successor shall be elected at the 2nd following spring election.

At board discretion the interview process can be used to appoint a new board member to fulfill the unexpired term. In the event of more than one party expressing interest in serving as a board member, there will be interviews conducted by the board for final selection.

If the remaining school board members have not appointed a replacement within 60 days of the date on which the vacancy first exists, each remaining board member will have the opportunity to place one candidate's name into consideration. The board shall then appoint the replacement via random drawing of one name from the list of candidates placed into consideration by the remaining members.
