A majority of the elected School Board members constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. In the absence of a quorum, the only official action that the Board may take is to adjourn the meeting to another time and/or date.

There shall be no alteration of salaries of teachers, or other employees of the Board, and no suspension of the policies, rules, and regulations unless a majority of the whole Board so votes.
