SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS GOALS

The best interests of the Lake Country Schools are served when lay citizens and professional school personnel work together for school improvement. Residents of the school district are encouraged to express their desires for the quality of education they wish to have in their schools.

One of the board's primary functions is to channel citizens' aspirations for their schools to the professional staff. To facilitate such channeling, the board will support appropriate devices, arrangements, procedures and organizations. The board, therefore, reaffirms and declares its intent as follows:

To keep the citizens of the district regularly and thoroughly informed through various channels of communication on the policies, program, problems, and planning of the school system, and to carry out this policy through its own efforts and the office of the District Administrator of Schools.

To invite the advice and counsel of the people of the District at all times and especially at all regularly scheduled Board meetings.

To solicit the sound thinking and skills of the people through advisory committees selected from the community and appointed by the board to consider those problems which vitally affect the future of the district's children.
