DEVELOPMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

300.13

The Board shall delegate to the District Administrator the function of specifying the required actions, and designing the detailed arrangements, under which the school will be operated. These detailed arrangements shall be defined in written form and organized in a manual for easy use. The administrative regulations must, in every respect, be consistent with the policies of the Board, statutory law, and case law.

The Board shall strive to formulate and adopt administrative regulations only when specific statutes require Board adoption. But the Board may also do so when the District Administrator recommends Board adoption is special circumstances.
