BUDGET APPEALS PROCEDURES

400.7

In the event that the electors reject the Board's proposed budget at the Annual Meeting, the Board shall determine its course of action at a regular or special meeting of the Board within 14 days of the Annual Meeting. Wisconsin Statutes provide for a remedy as follows:

The School Board of a common school district shall on or before November 1st, determine the amount necessary to be raised to operate and maintain the schools of the School District if the Annual Meeting has not voted a tax sufficient for such purposes for the ensuing school term. On or before November 6th, the School District Clerk shall certify the appropriate amount so determined to each appropriate municipal clerk who shall assess the amount certified to him and enter it on the tax rolls as other School District taxes are assessed and entered.
