EXTRA CURRICULAR SUPERVISOR

500.26

Chaperons of school events (e.g. dances, athletic games, field trips) shall have the following responsibilities:

1. General supervision: As an assigned supervisor for the event, a chaperon will have the same type of control over a student as a teacher in a classroom situation. The supervisor has the authority to give immediate consequences for unacceptable conduct. Misconduct may include:
 - obscene language
 - name calling
 - littering
 - smoking
 - drinking
 - leaving an event and returning
 - fighting
 - inappropriate physical contact
2. Misconduct Reporting: Chaperons shall report questionable acts or conduct to the principal. These reports should be made in writing and include the student's action and the chaperon's action.
3. Special Responsibilities for Bus Chaperons: When serving as a bus chaperon, the chaperon shall take a roll call of students. In addition, the chaperon shall be responsible for enforcing the following rules:
 - a. Students must ride to and from an event on the bus. An exception shall be made when a parent/guardian requests, in person, to remove his/her child(ren) from the bus.
 - b. All regular bus rider rules will apply.
 - c. Students must follow the dictates of sportsmanship and Lake Country athletic code.
 - d. Know location of first aid kit.
