STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

700.26

Students riding buses are subject to Wisconsin Statutes dealing with bus transportation, Board policies, rules and procedures established by the Bus Supervisor, and reasonable rules and procedures as determined by the drivers.

Students who do not cooperate or conduct themselves in a manner conducive to the safety of themselves or others, shall be disciplined by their building principal and/or bus driver. Drivers shall report violations of rules to the Bus Transportation Supervisor on the Bus Conduct Report, a copy of which will be mailed to the parent.

The privilege of riding the school bus may be denied or withdrawn temporarily by the pupil's building principal or the District Administrator. Drivers may refuse to transport pupils only if an immediate report of the circumstances is made to the building principal, Bus Transportation Supervisor, or District Administrator. No pupil shall be forced off a school bus when enroute unless his/her behavior is dangerous to the safety of themselves or other riders and proper authorities have first been contacted. Parents shall be notified in writing when riding privileges have been denied and a copy shall be filed in the District Administrator's office.
