SAFETY PROGRAM

700.2

The board will take every possible precaution to protect the safety of students, employees, and other citizens present on district property or at school sponsored events.

The board will comply with all safety requirements established by governmental authorities and will insist that its staff adhere to recommended safety practices as these pertain to the school plant, special areas of instruction, student transportation, school sports, and so on.

The practice of safety also will be considered a facet of the instructional program of the district schools. Instruction in accident prevention, fire prevention, emergency procedures, and highway safety will be provided in appropriate grades and classes.

Principals will be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for their schools, however, the district administrator will have overall responsibility for the safety program of the district. It will be the responsibility of the district administrator to see that staff members are kept informed of pertinent state and local regulations and the recommendations relating to safety in schools.
