## PRODUCT LIABILITY 700.42

The following is a list of guidelines regarding product liability:

## 1. <u>Products made by employees or students that are sold as</u> <u>fund</u> <u>raising activity.</u>

Students, with the assistance of staff, would be able to make products and resell them to the public at a profit. Approval from the building principal, district administrator, and the school board must be obtained. Proper supervision must be made when purchasing supplies for the product when making the product. Examples of products made would be pizzas, sandwiches, etc.

## 2. <u>Products made by students as a learning experience that</u> <u>they</u> <u>take home or sell to the public at no profit.</u>

Students would be able to make projects in class as part of the instructional program. Approval by the teacher should be given to the project before it is allowed to be taken off school property. Examples of products made by students would be industrial art projects, etc.
