The following goals are essential for quality instruction in the Lake Country School System:

- 1. Teachers should be assigned only to areas for which they possess adequate training.
- 2. Teaching in the classroom should take precedence over all other school activities. Interruption of classroom activities should be kept to a minimum.
- 3. Teachers should regularly reevaluate the goals, objectives, and methods of their courses of content.
- 4. Every student should have access to excellent library facilities and materials.
- 5. Technology is an integrated part of our instruction. The Board approves the three year technology plan as part of an instructional goal.
- 6. The total 4K-8 instructional program should be studied on a regular basis to determine needs for updating or otherwise altering the scope and sequence of the program offerings.
- 7. Teachers should strive to develop the following ideals in their students:
 - a. Moral and cultural values
 - b. An appreciation and acceptance of the work ethic
 - c. Self-reliant scholarship, originality and initiative
 - d. Leadership and follower
 - e. A command of the basic academic skills
