INSTRUCTIONAL GOALS

800.1

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The following goals are essential for quality instruction in the Lake Country School System:

1. Teachers should be assigned only to areas for which they possess adequate training.
2. Teaching in the classroom should take precedence over all other school activities. Interruption of classroom activities should be kept to a minimum.
3. Teachers should regularly reevaluate the goals, objectives, and methods of their courses of content.
4. Every student should have access to excellent library facilities and materials.
5. Technology is an integrated part of our instruction. The Board approves the three year technology plan as part of an instructional goal.
6. The total 4K-8 instructional program should be studied on a regular basis to determine needs for updating or otherwise altering the scope and sequence of the program offerings.
7. Teachers should strive to develop the following ideals in their students:
 - a. Moral and cultural values
 - b. An appreciation and acceptance of the work ethic
 - c. Self-reliant scholarship, originality and initiative
 - d. Leadership and follower
 - e. A command of the basic academic skills
