Section H: Instruction

KINDERGARTEN POLICY

800.17

In light of the State legislated requirements of section 120.13 (14) and 121.02 (e) (Kindergarten) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Lake Country School Board adopts the following policy in compliance with this law.

The Lake Country School District shall operate a kindergarten program in which all legally eligible children of the district who are 5 years old prior to September 1st of the current school year may be enrolled. The teachers shall be licensed by the Department of Public Instruction of the State of Wisconsin to teach kindergarten.

Physical facilities, equipment and materials shall be provided for a program which includes opportunities for learning basic concepts and skills in language arts, fine arts, social studies, science, mathematics, health and physical education.

The Lake Country School District kindergarten program shall consist of seven hours of instruction each day. Parents may request a modified day by filing a waiver request with the District Administrator or his/her designee.
