STUDENT SOCIAL EVENTS

The school board believes that social activities in school life assist students in learning how to enjoy worthwhile group events, how to conduct them, and how to contribute to the enjoyment of others. Therefore, school groups and classes may use school facilities to hold social events for their membership.

Well-conceived and well-managed social events are vital to the healthy growth of young people. Parties, dances, and comparable social events have an important place in a well-rounded school program. The staff is encouraged to use such events intelligently and in the best interests of students, parents and the school.

The building principal shall have the authority to regulate all student social events.

Proper chaperoning shall be provided under direction of the principal.
