Teachers shall be encouraged to make students available for public performances. Performances are a most important part of a student's musical experience. Each student is depended on for support and balanced sound, if a student is not present that is not possible. If a student is ill that night, the absence is excused. When performances are missed and unexcused, an assignment will be given.

1. All performances involving the use of students shall be approved by the building principal.

2. Students participating in a performance shall conduct themselves in a manner appropriate for their ages and in such a way as to bring credit to their school
