INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS SELECTION

800.26

The Lake Country School Board is legally responsible for all matters relating to the operation of the school district. The responsibility for the selection of instructional materials, however, is delegated to the professionally trained certified personnel of the district.

Selection of materials may involve instructional media specialists, principals, teachers, students, administrator, and community persons of the Lake Country School District. The selection and purchase of instructional materials shall be the responsibility of the Lake Country school staff.

Specific selection procedures shall be developed for use in the district. The Arrowhead Consortium Curriculum Task Force may also recommend the selection of certain materials.

The Lake Country School District shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of instructional and library materials on the basis of sex, color, religion, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
