TEXTBOOK SELECTION AND ADOPTION

800.27

It is the policy of the board of education to provide educational materials and equipment that support and enrich the curriculum and further the achievement of the district's instructional goals.

The selection of textbooks, supplementary books, and reference books is carried on continuously in order to keep up with the great expansion of knowledge and the rapid changes going on in our world today. The Lake Country Library Media/Selection Curriculum Review Committee will review curriculum and assist in selection of library media materials.

Insofar as possible, all textbooks should present balanced views concerning the international, national, and local issues, equity and problems of our times.

No book shall be adopted for use or be used in the District which falsifies facts. The Lake Country School District shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of instructional and library materials on the basis of sex, color, religion, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
