- 1. Promote a process of continuous evaluation of student performance.
- 2. Inform the student and his/her parent(s) or guardian of the student's progress through report card and parent-teacher conferences. This includes the use of technology through our district student management system and email.
- 3. Provide a basis for bringing about change in student performance if such change is deemed necessary.

Specific grading systems shall be developed for various grade levels by the district administrator and teaching staff. The main focus of assessment is to diagnose a students needs. Grades should not be used as punishment.

The Lake Country School District shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for evaluating students on the basis of sex, color, religion race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
