School shall be held and students shall receive actual instruction for at least 180 days each year.

The Department of Public Instruction has interpreted the intent of the 180 days standard to mean that students must be assured a minimum of 180 days of actual instruction. Time taken from the regular school day for parent-teacher conferences, inservice and emergency closing shall be made up upon approval of the school board, through the negotiation process.
