EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

The Board expects and encourages the professional staff to continuously study and update all aspects of the curriculum. It expects the District Administrator and his/her administrative staff to keep the Board informed of the need for new or revised programs. To accomplish this, the District Administrator shall organize committees to develop the administrative procedures needed for curriculum revision, implementation and evaluation of results. All groups affected by the curriculum changes should be included in these efforts whenever possible and desirable.

The District Administrator shall conduct an annual review of curriculum development in addition to such interim reviews as the District Administrator desires. The results of this annual review (as well as interim reviews) shall be reported to the Board of Education.
