MANDATED SCHOOL OBSERVANCES
800.45

The building principals shall be responsible for the following school observances as mandated by Statutes:

1. At least one day each week, the school day shall begin with a salute to the Flag and the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Provisions shall be made to observe the following days:

January 15 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
February 12 Lincoln's Birthday
February 15 Susan B. Anthony's Birthday
February 22 Washington's Birthday
March 4 Casimir Pulaski Day
April 13 American Creed Day
September 16 Mildred Fish Harnack Day
September 17 U.S. Constitution Day
September 28 Frances Willard Day
October 9 Leif Erickson Day
October 12 Columbus Day
November 11 Veteran's Day
Or any special day as required by Wis. Stats.
If any of the special days falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the observance shall be held on a school day immediately preceding or following the special day.

Last Friday in April - Arbor Day
