Section H Instruction

INTERSCHOLASTIC AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES 800.50

All organizations and activities sponsored by the Lake Country School District shall:

1. Provide educational opportunities for additional teaching and learning.
2. Meet basic educational criteria established by the professional and administrative staff.

Any organization or activity that does not meet the educational objectives and philosophy of the school system shall be suspended upon recommendation of the administration.

All full-time students are eligible to participate in student organizations and activities. The district will ensure that students with financial hardships will not be denied access for participation. This will be done in a private manner.

The Lake Country School District shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, national origin, religion, ancestry, creed, color, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.

GUIDELINES FOR EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The athletic and extra curricular activities of the Lake Country School District is a vital part of the educational process helping each individual reach and meet their physical, mental, emotional and social potential.

Code of Ethics

Athletes, coaches, parents, students, and instructors involved in programs will follow the Code of Ethics listed below:

1. Strive to improve the skills, knowledge and appreciation of all extra curricular activities.
2. Conduct yourself in an appropriate manner and recognize that you are a representative of the Lake Country School District.
3. Strive to develop and maintain good citizenship, sportsmanship and leadership.
4. Carry out all responsibilities expected of them by the school, coaches and advisors.
5. Abide by the rules of the game or activity.
6. Respect the judgment and integrity of sports officials, judges, and in fellow members.

Athletic/Extra Curricular Code

1. Classroom work has priority over extra curricular and sport events. Coaches and sponsors of extra curricular activities will periodically check with classroom teachers to determine students' academic and attitudinal need for improvement. Conferences between the student, teacher, coach and parent may be in order. After other intervention has failed, as a last resort, the teacher and coach may require students with reoccurring or serious problems to be removed from a game, portion of a game, or from other extracurricular activities. (Student serving detention may not participate in sports events or extra curricular activities on the day of detention.)
2. Students who have received in-school suspensions or out-of-school suspensions will not participate in any after school event that day.
3. Detention issued on a practice or game day will be served that day. The player must then report to the practice or game to observe. Student is not to play in the game or activity.
4. The use of alcohol, drugs or tobacco and socially inappropriate behavior will be the immediate dismissal from the team.

5. Language or conduct that is viewed as being inappropriate will result in the immediate dismissal from the gym.

After School Procedures

1. Students staying for games will assemble in a designated area under the supervision of an adult.
2. Soda, candy and/or snacks can be eaten before the game in designated areas only, but must be brought from home. Once a student leaves the school building, they are not to return to school.
3. Students are not to stay at school for late practices. Students can arrive 15 minutes before practices or games begin. Transportation needs to be arranged before and after practices.
4. Students are to remain in the gym during games.
5. Language or behavior that is unacceptable will result in the student being sent home.
