If school system is to offer an educational program which is meaningful to its pupils and relevant to the times in which they live, it is absolutely essential that it constantly review its curriculum and, where necessary, revise it or develop it anew. Instructional committees shall be established to plan continuous and ongoing improvements in the areas of curriculum and instruction. Representation on the Arrowhead Area Curriculum Task Force shall be established. Each Curriculum Task Force will plan, design, and assess curriculum according to the Arrowhead Area Curriculum Task Force cycle. The Curriculum Task Force will contribute to the textbook and material adoption.
