Policies of the Board of Education

Section I Students

STUDENT CONDUCT 900.25

All student behavior will be based on respect and consideration for the rights of others. Students have a responsibility to know and follow the rules and regulations of the school.

Students have the further responsibility to behave in a manner appropriate to good citizenship everywhere. Any restrictions on student behavior must be concerned with speech or action which disrupts the work of the school or interferes with the rights of other students.

The district administrator is responsible for developing and administering reasonable rules and regulations for students. Such rules and regulations shall not conflict with Board policies, statutory law or case law.

All employees and administrative staff shall share responsibility for supervising the behavior of students and for seeing that they meet the standards of conduct established by the administrator. In enforcing rules for student conduct, staff members shall place particular emphasis upon educating students in the ability to control themselves.

The Lake Country School District shall not discriminate in standards and rules of behavior, including student harassment, on the basis of sex, race, national origin, color, religion, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
