

Policies of the Board of Education

Section I Students

STUDENT ALCOHOL/DRUG ABUSE

900.30

No student shall use, possess, distribute, sell or be under the influence of alcohol or controlled substances on school premises, in a school vehicle or while engaged in or attending school-sponsored activities. This prohibition does not apply to the authorized use of prescription drugs by a student with the written permission of his/her parent/guardian and physician.

A school administrator, principal or teacher for the Lake Country School District is not liable solely for referring a pupil of the school to law enforcement authorities, or the removing a pupil from school property for suspicion of possession, distribution, or consumption of alcohol/drugs.

If a school official or police officer has reasonable suspicion that a student is under the influence of alcohol in violation of this policy, he/she shall require the student to submit to a breathalyzer test to determine the presence of alcohol. This test shall be administered by the police-school liaison officer or another police officer. The results of the breathalyzer test or the fact that a student refused to submit to breath testing shall be used in student disciplinary proceedings.

Students who violate this policy, or refuse to submit to required breath testing to determine the presence of alcohol, shall be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with board policies and established procedures.
