Available to 4K Lake Country School Students
Monday through Friday on school days

7:50 a.m. - Students arrive at school and meet teachers at the Activities Entrance.

Lunch: Students may purchase a hot lunch from the Lake Country School lunchroom, or they may bring a healthy/nut-free bag lunch. Lunch is eaten in the classroom or in the school lunchroom. We encourage healthy eating habits including fruits and vegetables, especially before our treats.

Independence: At Stay & Play we stress independence. Some examples are: cleaning up your lunch space and toys, gathering your own items, setting up your rest space, putting on your own outdoor items and shoes, and other opportunities throughout the day.

Rest Time: Each day, students will have a quiet rest time for approximately 45 minutes. Please send your child a rest mat, towel, small travel size pillow, and 1 small stuffed animal to stay at school. The cloth items will be sent home at least monthly for washing.

Library: Our classroom library is open on a daily basis. Books are changed out regularly. We read stories every day, and listen to books on tape. We love books!!!

Activities: We do a lot of hands-on exploration through different activities including crafts, nature walks, sledding, painting, games, and more! We work on writing your own name, colors, numbers, shapes, letters, puzzles, counting, sorting, and words. We practice using scissors, buttoning, zippers, using tweezers, lacing, stringing, and other fine motor skills. We practice sharing, taking turns, and other social skills. We enjoy recess, rainbow relaxation, brain breaks, and other gross motor activities. Students are given a free choice of activities at Center Time.
